Cooperation and European network has been developed through collaboration and partnership with different European countries, with whom we have frequent correspondence for the realization of joint projects. To facilitate the meeting of various stakeholders interested in the development of shared projects, we designed a new networking format "Creative Breakfasts", which is a tool that we utilize also abroad.

Often, our projects are inclusive, especially for disadvantaged or people with disabilities, in 2017 in fact, we are going to realize a training project for operators and educators on integrated processes of dance theater. In this framework, we are also engaged in Rovereto Oriente Occidente network - Moving Beyond Inclusion project and in the Italian network named #unlimited.

We participate actively in the network of the "Teatri Solidali" of the Metropolitan City of Bologna in support of exhibitions promoted by the Minguzzi Institute, maximum authority to protect the culture of inclusion in Bologna.

We develop new models of learning regarding self - employment and active participation of young people with SoJuEn project, the second edition in 2017, has the aim of promoting self-employment through land care.

The organization has had over the last two years a significant development in the generation of new training products and formats useful for networking. With the acquisition of the Design Thinking methodology, Creativi108 has been able to generate a non-formal education program for young Change Makers: SoJuEn. A useful proposal to integrate the active participation and experience of entrepreneurship. In May 2017, the Association was coordinator of the "Social Innovation Match", an event of Keynote Speech about the theme of social innovation in education with 12 European organizations. The event was a great opportunity for sharing the association's experience in the field of social innovation by presenting her project SoJuEn to other 12 organisations. The event led to the expansion of the network of contacts and disseminate good practice among the organizations involved. Two of those organisations of Social Innovation Match are also partners of that project today. Creativi108's mission is to create a Human Centered Design approach, where it is restored the value of human relationships within the training and employment contexts.
